



Social Thinking Vocabulary: Connect Four

Activity Directions:

1. Create a Power Point slide with the Connect Four board and two dozen circles of two or three different colors (depending on if you have two or three players)
2. Give the students Remote Access so they can click and drag colored circles on to the board. If you are unable to grant remote access, have the students use the zoom annotate tool to draw their colored circles on the board. Or you can make the game on Google Drawing or Google Slides and share the document with them, giving them editing privileges and all players can then move the images around on their on computer
3. During the game coach the students to *keep their brain and body in the group, think with their eyes to notice when it is their turn, follow the group plan, and use their flexible thinking and use their brain filter* if they win.
4. Optional: to teach older elementary school kids about Wonder Questions or Add-A-Thought, you can have them ask a question or add a comment with each turn they take. To support this, you can write “ask a question” or “add a thought” on each colored circle in the game.
